GENERAL CARE TIPS

a. Clean with Soft Cloth/Sponge

Clean the coated surface with a soft, non-abrasive cloth or sponge to remove dust and smudges. This prevents scratching and maintains the clarity and integrity of the coating without affecting its performance or appearance.

b. Use Mild, Non-Ammonia-based Cleaners

Apply a mild, ammonia-free glass cleaner to gently remove dirt, oils, and fingerprints. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth rather than directly on the surface to ensure even application and reduce the risk of over-saturating the coating.

c. Avoid Harsh Chemicals/Abrasive Cleaning Products

Do not use abrasive pads, harsh chemicals, or sharp tools on the coated surface. These can scratch, cloud, or damage the protective layer, reducing its effectiveness and compromising the clarity or finish of the material.

d. Inspect Coating Periodically

Periodically check the coated surface for any signs of wear, peeling, or damage. Early identification and prompt maintenance ensure the coating remains functional and visually clear, helping to extend its lifespan and performance.

e. Avoid Adhesives/Sticky Materials

Do not apply stickers, tapes, or adhesive materials directly on the coated surface. These can leave behind stubborn residue or cause surface degradation when removed, impacting both the look and performance of the coating.
